**1.1 Introduction**

This prospectus relates to admission to D.Pharm course in Lisie College of Pharmacy, Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Vennala Campus, Vennala High School Road, Ernakulam, Kochi-682028.

This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to D.Pharm course for the academic year 2021-22 in Lisie College of Pharmacy. Selection of candidates will be purely on merit basis. The college has its own policies of reservations in admitting students. This prospectus is subject to modification/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said Institution and also subject to further orders if any passed by courts of law.

### 2.2 Status of Affiliation/Approval of D.Pharm course for the academic year 2021-22

The two-year D.Pharm course conducted at Lisie College of Pharmacy is approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (111 CC unlfItem No.52 (6 & 7 April, 2021): 280 -KL-12 / 2021-2022) & All India Council for Technical Education (EOA: F.No. South-West/1-9319539723/2021/EOA dated 25 June 2021) and is affiliated to Board of D.Pharm Examinations, Directorate of Medical Education, Govt. of Kerala.

### 2.3 Details of seats

Details of allotment procedure and conditions to be fulfilled by a candidate to apply under General merit seats and Community merit seats are as follows.

#### 2.3.1 General Merit

All the applicants are eligible to be considered under General merit.

#### 2.3.2 Community Merit Quota

Candidates belonging to all Christian denominations are eligible to be considered in the community merit seats. Community certificate

issued by Revenue authorities shall be produced to prove the claim. Unfilled seats in this category will be reverted to General merit.

### 3. Eligibility for Admission

**3.1** Citizenship: Candidates must be citizens of India

**3.2.** Academic Qualification: Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics/ are eligible.

OR

An equivalent examination approved by the Pharmacy Council of India for admission to D.Pharm.

Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination.

### 3.3 Age

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.12.2021. There is no upper age limit for D.Pharm course.

### 4. Procedure for obtaining Prospectus and submission of online application

Candidates are advised to take a printout of the submitted application form.

Facility for taking out the “print of application form submitted” is also provided in the College office.

Please note that the candidate **need not submit** the printout out of application or any other documents to the College office.

### **5. Preparation of Rank List**

Selection will be based on the rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Physics and Chemistry in the Second year of the qualifying examination. If there is a tie, marks obtained in Chemistry will be considered, if there is still a tie, marks obtained in English will be considered. Again if there is a tie, then the candidate with higher age on the date of counseling will be considered.

### 7. Procedure of Admission

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the College after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Special fee etc. as mentioned in the **clause. 9**, failing which, the offer of admission will be cancelled. Fees can be paid by online mode through the link given in our website [www.lcop.edu.in](http://www.lcop.edu.in).

SC/ST candidates will have to pay the normal fees. The fees will be refunded as and when the Government reimburses their fees to the College.

### 8. Documents to be submitted at the time of Admission

The following documents **in original** along with one set of self attested copies shall be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Marks Card of qualifying examination (Higher secondary or Equivalent)
2. Eligibility/ Equivalence certificate if the candidate has passed the qualifying examination from other states
3. SSLC Certificate/10<sup>th</sup> Standard certificate
4. T.C. from the institution last studied.
5. Character and Conduct certificate from the institution last studied
6. Physical fitness certificate from Medical officer
7. Community Certificate from Revenue Officer (if admitted under community seats)
8. Recent passport size photograph (Six copies) and a soft copy in CD
9. Copy of AADHAR card.
